Curriculum

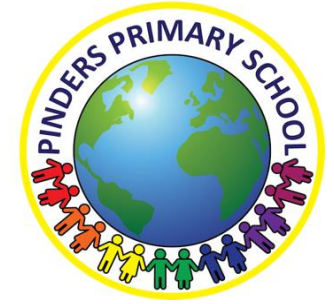
- Phonics – *Little Wandle Scheme*

Communication with Parents

How will I know how my child is doing and what they are doing?

- Teachers will be available at the door in the morning and at home time
- A *homework information sheet* each week provides information about what we have been learning about that week and how you can help at home.
- *Class Dojo* will be the main way we will communicate to you in Reception. We will upload photos of things we have been doing in class, to show record 'milestones' and reminders of things to come.
- *ParentPay/Arbor* is how we will communicate whole school information with you via email and text.
- *Parents evenings* in the Autumn and Spring term.
- You will receive and *end of EYFS report* in July.

- Putting their coat on/ off and zipping it up
